



Clinical Therapist Job Description

In this role, you will work directly with clients to actively listen to problems and concerns. The Clinical Therapist will respond in a culturally sensitive and trauma-informed manner. This role requires someone who enjoys working closely with people—not just with clients, but also with other members of our team and partner agencies. Our company culture is friendly, flexible, and family-oriented. This position is 20-40+ hours per week and may be eligible for benefits including medical, dental, vision insurance and paid-time-off.

Therapist Duties and Responsibilities

- ❖ Provide mental health and/or substance abuse counseling to individuals, couples and families.
- ❖ Conduct assessments and evaluations to determine diagnosis using DSM-5 criteria.
- ❖ Assist client in identifying treatment goals and develop holistic treatment plan.
- ❖ Implement various treatment modalities to appropriately address client situations.
- ❖ Continually assess client situations and progress, tailoring approach to individual client's needs.
- ❖ Educate and involve family members, other loved ones, and service providers in the treatment process when necessary.
- ❖ Record and maintain adequate notes about client visits and contacts. Collect outcome data. Provide resources and referrals to help clients meet their needs.
- ❖ Communicate effectively with referring and partner agencies.

- ❖ Attend supervision and all agency meetings/trainings.
- ❖ Maintain the strictest confidentiality of every client situation.
- ❖ Maintain required licenses and adhere to ethical code of profession.
- ❖ Ability to effectively use office technology (electronic medical records, telehealth platforms)

Minimum Qualifications

- ❖ Minimum of Master's in Social Work, Professional Counseling, or similar degree from an accredited university program.
- ❖ Currently licensed in Wisconsin as an APSW, LPC-IT, or as a LCSW, LPC or LMFT. Supervision for APSW/LPC-IT completing their 3,000 clinical hours is available.
- ❖ Experience providing culturally sensitive mental health treatment and/or working with diverse populations.
- ❖ Willing to provide counseling to clients ages 8+ years old, couples, and families.
- ❖ Excellent interpersonal communication skills with the ability to actively listen.
